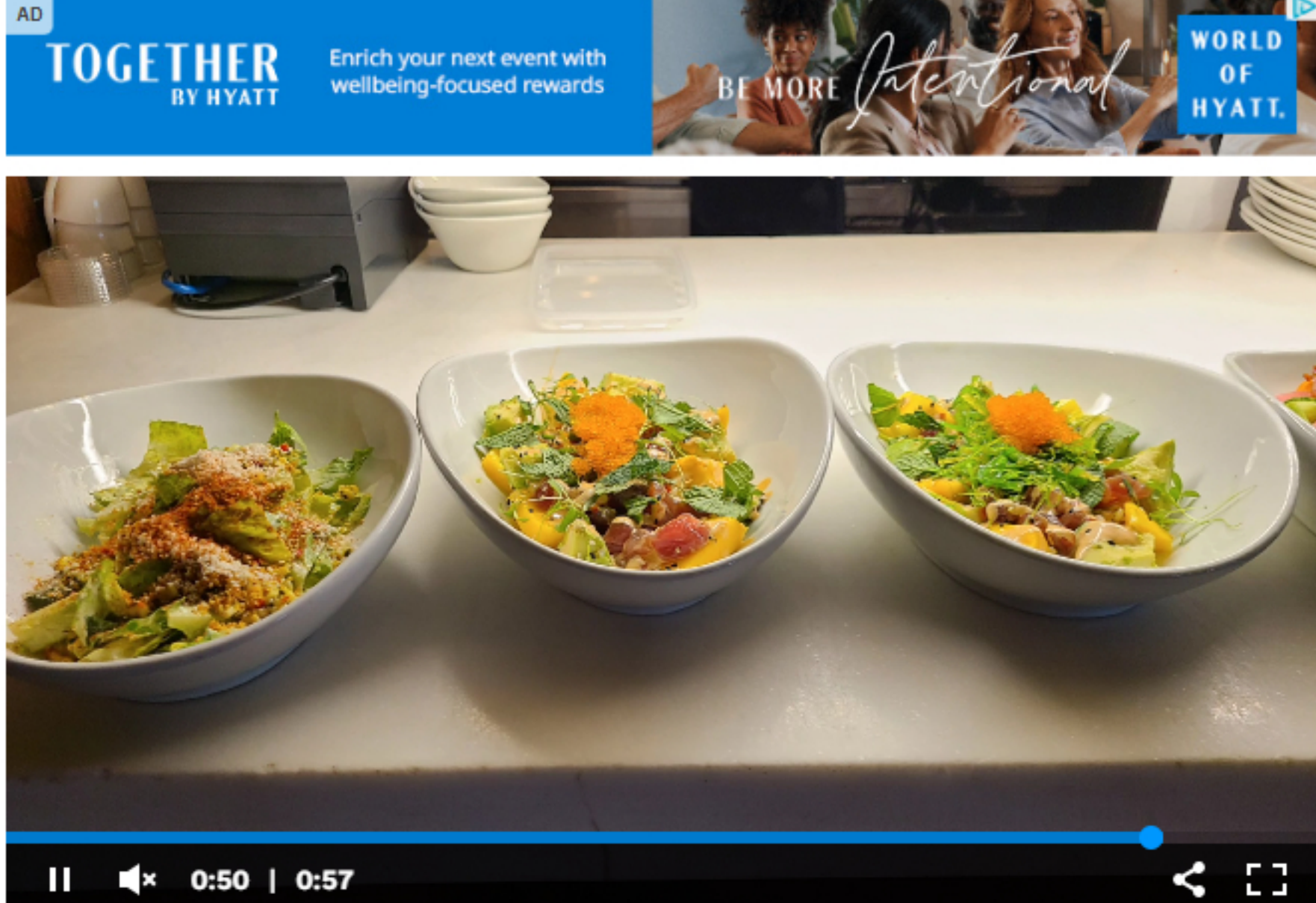

One Palm Beach County restaurant has earned a spot on [The New York Post](#)'s recently published list of the 10 best celebrity-owned restaurants. The list was based based upon a study by [Cases.gg](#) whose methodology incorporated Tripadvisor and Google five-star reviews.

Jupiter's [1000 North](#) grabbed the seventh-place slot, averaging 74% five-star reviews.

Though Michael Jordan was singled out as 1000 North's owner in the other Post, it ranks high, almost Planet Hollywood high, when it comes to the number of celebrity partners and backers who include Tucker Frederickson, Ernie Els, Marvin Shanken, Brooks Koepka, Keegan Bradley, Rickie Fowler, Dustin Johnson, Justin Thomas, Luke Donald and Serena Williams.

- New York City's S&P Lunch (previously known as Eisenberg's, my former weekly haunt for its chocolate egg creams) is No. 3. Its celeb tie in is Nicholas Braun from "Succession."
- With five locations spanning Georgia, Kentucky, South Carolina and Tennessee, the semi-eponymous Nic & Norman's at No. 4 is from Greg Nicotero and Norman Reedus from "The Walking Dead."

- At No. 5, El's Giuliana Rancic and hubby Bill Rancic, the first-ever winner of "The Apprentice" starring POTUS Donald J. Trump in 2004, are partners in Chicago's RPM Steak.
